TO COMPLETE YOUR REGISTRATION

- 1. Mail, Fax, or Email the application to TSSAA....AND
- 2. Go to the TSSAA website at www.tssaa.org and click on OFFICIALS. Click link for "Registration" and complete the online registration with the TSSAA/ArbiterSports. When prompted for payment type simply "Sign Out".
- 3. Send an email to go@tssaa.org that you have completed the Student Online Registration. We will then complete your registration when we receive your completed application. Books and exam information will be mailed to you.

TSSAA STUDENT OFFICIALS PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS

Program is on an experimental level in all sports. The use of high school students to register (with affiliate status) will receive training through a local association.

High schools are asked to recruit high school students who are interested in officiating athletic contests. Student will register with TSSAA as Student Official with affiliate status. Applications can be printed from the TSSAA website: www.tssaa.org.

There will be no registration fee charged with TSSAA for affiliate status and they must be associated with a TSSAA recognized local officials' association. Materials will be mailed to each student official.

There will be no registration fee during status as a student official with the local association.

The student official will work within the local association to receive education, training, and observation as a student official.

The registered student official may work B-team or J.V. athletic contests <u>only</u> in football, basketball, baseball, and softball when working with qualified official (s) assigned by approved local association. They may work B-team, J.V. or middle school in volleyball, wrestling, and soccer when working with qualified official (s) assigned by approved local association. The student official will receive the same game fee as the middle school fee for that particular sport.

Schools will recruit and recommend students that are willing to register as student officials.
